INCLUSIVE & EQUITABLE EDUCATION

Aneed based Capacity Building Trainingon Inclusive Education(IE)

Seva-in-Action (SiA) organized three-day residential training program focused on Inclusive Education (IE) for ADD India's field staff at its facility in Koramangala, Bengaluru, on their specific request. The training program was meticulously designed, encompassing content, training methodology, duration, and expected outcomes, all in line with ADD India's midterm evaluation recommendations.

The Launchofthe3-Day IE Training (watering a plant by the field workers)

The three-day residential capacity building



training took place at Seva-in-Action, Koramangala, Bengaluru, spanning from 12thto 14th September, 2023 with the support of Mr. Girish, resident instructor. A total of 20 individuals (11 males & 9 females) from ADD India, participated, representing five distinct project areas across Karnataka, (Chikkaballapur, Kanakapura, Guldlupet, Guledagudda, and Chittapur).

The Training's Objective

The training aimed to equip participants with a comprehensive understanding of inclusive education, in line with the UNCRPD (United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities). It covered aspects like comprehension of inclusive practices and the roles of different stakeholders.

Methodology

The methodology employed was interactive, used to impart knowledge and ensure effective comprehension of the content. It involved group discussions, presentations,

and open forums for participants to ask questions, provide feedback, and offer suggestions. Training materials included pre and post-tests, PowerPoint presentations, an



IE handbook, and session-specific handouts. Trainers and Facilitators The training sessions were skilfully conducted by Ms. Manjula Nanjundaiah, Director of Seva-in-Action along with the resource persons invited from other organizations.

Training Evaluation, Post-Test

Upon concluding the training program, a post-test was administered, revealing that nearly all participants had acquired a comprehensive understanding of IE and the distinction between Equality and Equity.



Outcome

While building the capacity of ADD India's community-based workers in a three-day training program presents inherent challenges, the training aimed to equip them with foundational knowledge to act as facilitators in establishing at least one model IE school in their respective areas. Given Mr. Lobithas, ED of ADD India, a strong commitment to inclusion, it is anticipated that he will carry this training forward to the implementation phase. This training program represents a significant step toward fostering a more inclusive and equitable education system for all.

Material in Inclusion (Level 2) for Teachers and BIERTs of all the Govt. Schools in Karnataka by Samagra Shikshana Karnataka(SSK)

NEP 2020 in align with the UN SDG 4 seeks to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all" by 2030. It aims to ensure equity and inclusion in and through education by addressing all forms of exclusion and marginalization, disparity, vulnerability and inequality in education access, participation, retention, and completion and in learning outcomes. With this background, the UNICEF has supported SSK in developing online courses for teachers on Equity and Inclusion by involving a team of experts. Teachers have already undergone Level 1 of the course on DIKSHA.It is in this context that a comprehensive training at Level 2 is proposed to build the capacity of both teachers and BIERTs to enhance the quality of inclusive education in Karnataka.


Mrs. Ruma Banerjee, Vice Chairperson and Ms. Manjula Nanjundaiah, Director of Seva-in-Action were invited by Samagra Shikshana Karnataka (SSK) along with the other experts (Dr. Anupam Ahuja, Dr. Anita Julka, Dr. Geet Oberoi, Prof. Jayanti Narayan, Dr. Varsha Ghatoo & Prof. Sujatha Bhan) to participate and give their useful inputs in the consultation workshop to finalize the framework for the Level 2 Inclusive Education course content on Aug 3-4, 2023, from 11 AM to 4 PM at the Office of the State Project Director, Nrupatunga Road, Bengaluru.

Ruma & Manjula from Seva-in-Action Written Chapters allotted to them based on the format decided in the two days' workshop and submitted to SSK. The UNICEF compiled all the 7 chapters written by experts and make a handbook called INCLUSIVE EDUCATION – Part 2 Teacher's Course Material.

We collated and incorporated Case studies / Success stories, assessment formats, ideas for assistive technology in the content related to our chapters.

Next level was creating Story Boards on 7 Modules with voice over for online IE course.

Manjula Nanjundaiah on invitation from the UNICEF did the proof reading of Kannada



version of all the 7 chapters of the Teacher's Course Material and also did the proof reading of Kannada version of the following 7 Modules of the Story Boardsfor SSK:

On the occasion of International Day of persons with disabilities, differently abled students from Hoskote Centre participated in the Sports organized by the BRC Office on Dec-2023








One-day Excursion







Quizabled is a distinctive quizzing program for children and Youths who are Differently Abled organized by Seva-in-Action (SIA), Bengaluru and powered by LTIMindtree. The 9th edition of Quizabled has become a pan India program and reached out to 10 States with 3000 children & youths with disabilities [Intellectual Disability (ID), Cerebral Palsy (CP), Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Visual Impairment (VI), and Hearing Impairment (HI)] from 320 schools.

It was extended to Kolkata, West Bengal & Lucknow, UttarPradesh & this year continued with Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Delhi, Odisha, Kerala, Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. Quizabled has progressed with the theme of "Celebrating Diversity & Empowering the lives".
